# AUGUST 2019 - SWEDISH WEAVING CHRISTMAS BELL





Ding – Ding! This is a beginner Swedish Weaving project designed by Frieda Carnell from the EGA's Petite Projects. We will learn the simple technique of Swedish weaving by using Aida cloth's floats as our grid to weave the threads over the surface. The materials kit will cost \$5, but they are limited! We only have 11 kits, so first come! The kits will include a modified chart and thread list, fabrics for the front and back, threads, beads and needle. Please bring the printed instructions which you received, your usual stitching supplies, a beading needle, (and your \$5) to the August meeting.
